### MEETING THE CHALLENGES OF DISSOCIATION: FROM RECOGNITION TO CONNECTION

The Bowlby Centre is presenting this one day workshop which is a unique opportunity for professionals to become more acquainted with the latest developments in understanding trauma and dissociation from a relational point of view.

Clients with Dissociative Disorders typically present a complex array of symptoms and are often considered as difficult patients. This workshop is about the fundamentals of dissociation as a distinct response to trauma that happens when aspects of the past remain in the present. The day will provide participants with a broad base of understanding ways of recognizing and relating better with this client group.
